SWAP MEET, FLEA MARKET, HEALTH & WELLNESS

4,315 sites; limited electric service. No food or beverages may be *sold*.

COMMERCIAL SWAP VENDOR: North of the Tower and indoor space(s) in vendor building. Limited electricity available.

Strictly Enforced - No Exceptions. Only Vendors will be allowed in for set up on Wednesday July 10. Staging begins 7:00 a.m. Wednesday, July 10. Gates will open at 10:00 a.m. No spectator admission prior to Thursday at 6:00 a.m.

No disruptive generators or construction generators allowed.

CAMPING

1,600 sites with shower facilities, water points, restrooms, reception center, and buses to the show grounds. No electrical hook-ups or on-site water. Campers who arrive earlier than 6:00 a.m. Thursday will be charged \$30.00 per space for Wednesday. Volunteers are not in this area until 10:00 am on Wednesday. NO entry before 10:00 a.m.

No open ground fires or bon fires. Self-contained fires are allowed, weather permitting. Do not dig fire pits. Grills/ campfires must be contained and attended at all times. Ashes must be disposed of in clearly marked containers found throughout the campground.

Vintage Camping has limited spaces near the campground barn, it is developed for Campers 1975 and older.

No disruptive generators or construction generators allowed.

CAR CORRAL

1,000 sites are available for people wanting to sell their vehicle(s). There is no cut-off year for a vehicle to be for sale in this area. The year 2000 and older will park in spaces numbered 1-34. 2001 and newer vehicles will park in 37-70. If pre-registered and have a picture available, we will post on web page prior to the show and until September 1st. Vehicles on trailers are allowed.

NEW VENDOR CATEGORIES INCLUDE FLEA MARKET AND HEALTH/WELLNESS VENDORS

For years we've worked hard to enforce the rules and integrity of the swap meet, asking vendors to focus classic, auto and nostalgic memorabilia items for sale in the swap meet. We've received a lot of requests from both buyers and sellers to broaden our criteria to also include other items. This year, we're adding two new categories with designated locations. In the Northeast corner of the grounds, near the concert venue, we'll place vendors for the new Flea Market category. The items allowed for sale in this area will be much broader than that of the swap area. Also new this year is the Health and Wellness area, which will allow vendors of products promoting all things health related. More information below in the NEW BUILDING section.

SWAP VENDOR MIGRATION AND REGISTRATION PROCESS (WEDNESDAY ONLY)

Like last year, vendor migration and setup will begin on Wednesday morning (July 10th). Gate 19 will open for staging beginning at 7am, using the color coded system. At 10am, we'll transition from the staging area into the showgrounds for setup through the designated gates. THERE IS NO ENTRY TO STAGING AREA PRIOR TO 7AM ON WEDNESDAY, PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY. The setup process is much more efficient this way, so don't feel the need to be first in line in order to enter the grounds at a reasonable time. We appreciate your cooperation on this improvement.

WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE NEW BUILDING?

As you may know, shortly before the 2018 event we purchased the large office building in the show car area that once housed Krause Publications. Since last year, we've been hard at work preparing the space for use during the show. This year, you can expect to see indoor show car space in both the Northeast and Southeast corners of the building. Right between the two, travel back in time with the Waupaca Area Model Railroaders and check out their impressive display.

The South side of the building will feature the entrance to the relocated Otto's Bar, and the indoor Health and Wellness vendors. In addition to the private vendors and products promoting all things health, we're working with Marshfield Clinic to offer a variety of screenings and consultations for those who may not have time to visit them otherwise.

WHERE'S OTTO'S BAR?!? (NEW LOCATION)

Don't worry, nobody's giving Otto and his team the boot. Rather, we're giving them an improved location! The indoor/outdoor courtyards in the new building is the perfect place to enjoy a relaxing time with friends at Otto's Bar and Beer Garden, located directly next to the indoor Special Exhibit area.

NO TEARDOWN UNTIL 5PM SATURDAY

In a continued effort to serve our attendees, swap vendors and sponsors are asked not to teardown their sites until at least 5pm on Saturday. Please cooperate with this rule to help keep show and vendor commerce strong now and into the future.
